

Freycinet National Park Camping Information

Freycinet National Park's campground is a small coastal strip along the dunes of Richardsons Beach and the granite knoll of Honeymoon Bay. All campsites are only metres from the waters edge and safe unpatrolled beaches. Freycinet National Park has a visitor centre and gift shop and an outdoor theatre. During summer a Discovery Ranger provides a range of activities. The local township of Coles Bay has general stores, petrol, ice and gas bottle refills.

The Powered sites Campsites I-18 are hardened camping sites that protect the fragile coast allowing for small (18ft) caravans and campervans a space with power, potable water, grey water disposal and an amenities block. There are two shared access tracks to the beach. Each site is approximately 7 metres x 4 metres

The Sand Dune Sites Campsites 19-45 are individual tent only camping nodes clearly delineated in the fore-dune vegetation. Each site has parking for one vehicle, shares a track to the beach and is within easy reach of potable water and modern amenity blocks that have cold water showers. Each site is approximately 6 metres x 7 metres

Honeymoon Bay Campsites 46-52 are perched upon a granite knoll overlooking the small Honeymoon Bay. These sites are some walk from the amenities and there is a potable water tap. Sites 52 and 53 have steep slippery driveways better suited to 4WD vehicles and require a longer walk to the toilets; these sites are not recommended for young children. Each site is approximately 6 metres x 7 metres

Bookings

The sand-dune and powered campsites can be pre-booked through the Freycinet Visitor Centre. Full payment is required. Maximum length of stay is 14 nights for up to 6 people per site. Notify the visitor centre if you plan to arrive a day late. All bookings not taken up by the first night will be deemed a no show and cancelled. Please call (03) 6256 7000

Cancellation fees

Sites cancelled at 30 or more days notice will incur a cancellation fee of 50% camping fees paid Less than 30 days notice 100% of camping fees paid.

Ballot period

A ballot is drawn on the Ist August to allocate sites for the Christmas summer season from 18th December to 10th February and also Easter. Only one entry per family/group is allowed for Christmas and another may be entered for Easter. Maximum stay is 10 nights for up to 6 people per site. Notification of the ballot draw will be as immediate after the draw as possible, usually two weeks.

Ballot period cancellations

7 days notice or more will incur a cancelation fee of 25% of payment 1-6 Days notice will incur a cancelation fee of 50% of payment No-show or cancellation on arrival 100% of camping payment
